On rare occasions, advanced junior high students may be eligible to earn high school credit for a high school course (e.g., Algebra). Junior high students recommended for high school coursework and wishing to earn high school credit must:

- Take a high school level course currently taught by a certified teacher at their school site;
- Earn an exemplary grade ("A" or "B") for each semester of the course;
- Work with the district counselor to complete an Early High School Credit Approval Form;
- Submit the completed form and grade report(s) to the CRSD Board of Education for review and possible approval.

Upon approval, the Early High School Credit Approval Form will become a part of the student's permanent file. The grade and high school credit earned will appear on the student's transcript during the freshman year.

NOTE:

- High school credit earned in junior high and appearing on the high school transcript *will* count in the student's cumulative high school grade point average.
- High school credit earned prior to the fall semester of 9th grade may count toward a student's core credit requirements but will not change the number of core content credits required during a student's high school career. (BP 6146c)
